



The curriculum focuses on the "Essential Practices of the Christian Faith."


In group time, we will consider challenges to those practices and engage in exercises that promote group connection.


This Lent we are offering Stepping Stone Circles for **Preschool**, **Kindergarten**, and **8th Grade students**, **parents and their families**.

JESUS **FOR ** PRESIDENT STUDY SERIES



In addition to the eight-week sermon series, we'll gather for a five-week Sunday morning study series.


Join the conversation between services in the Heritage Room January 26th, February 2, 16, 23, and March 2.
